

Schedule of Fees – 2010

School Fees & Collection Policy (Para 2.1)

“While Commonwealth and State Grants provide some income for Catholic schools, the other major source of income is from fees. Since the College is a Catholic School Community, the fees seek to be affordable and enable the College to provide relevant programs, specialised resources and qualified staff. The payment of fees is the shared responsibility of all families.”

SCHOOL FEES

All families are billed in October to confirm enrolments for the following year. The 4 term instalments are due by 15 Nov, 15 Feb, 15 May, and 15 Aug. Families have the option to pay the annual fee in 10 monthly instalments which are due by 15th of each month from November to August.

The School Fee includes a tuition fee and the following levies:

- **Building Levy** (\$720) is used to assist with loan repayments on buildings.
- **Annual Levy** (\$1,000) covers year level camps, curriculum based excursions, class sets, additional materials and all other necessary items required including the Magazine, Calendar, Planner and Photos.

Please note that there is no tax deductible component to the above compulsory school fees.

Subject Levy applies to some elective subjects to purchase additional items, as notified in either the Curriculum Guide or Booklist.

SIBLING DISCOUNTS and the Shared Family Fee Reduction Scheme

Mater Christi College and **St Joseph’s College**, Ferntree Gully, have a “**Shared Family Fee Reduction Scheme**” to assist parents.

The discount for students attending Mater Christi College is applied to school fees as follows:

2nd child = 15%

3rd child = 30%

4th plus child = 85%

This discount is applied automatically to sisters attending Mater Christi College. It is necessary to complete an application form **only** if your daughter has an older brother attending St Joseph’s College. Application forms are available from the main reception of Mater Christi.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

- Flexible payment options available - BPay (phone or internet), Credit Card, Cash, or Cheque. Monthly payers can also choose Direct Debit or Automatic Credit Card payments.
- For new families, the default payment frequency is 4 billings per annum. If any new or existing family prefers monthly payment, please contact the Finance Team to discuss.
- **ADMINISTRATION DISCOUNT of \$150 per student** is applied when the balance of the total school fee is paid in full before 15 February 2010. The November instalment must be paid by the due date. The discount is applied pro-rata for student’s receiving a scholarship.

OPTIONAL PROGRAMMES

MUSIC: Private music tuition fees and instrumental hire are charged separately for each semester.

MCC BUS: The Mater Christi Charter bus is charged separately as per the Bus Travel Application form.

No student will be allowed the privilege of participating in voluntary activities (e.g. instrumental music lessons, Central Australia trip, overseas trip) whilst schools fees remain outstanding.

REFUND POLICY

A full term’s notice in writing to the Principal is required, in accordance with the Terms of Enrolment, when withdrawing your daughter from the College or one term’s fee is payable in lieu of this notice. Any unused tuition fees may be refunded. Levies are not refundable.
